



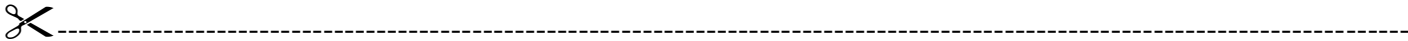
## Whetu Rere - the sea lion and the comet

On the Otago coast, something extraordinary is happening. The world's rarest sea lion species has begun a tentative comeback to the mainland of New Zealand. Just one exceptional female is pioneering her species' historic return.

Whetu Rere - the sea lion and the comet gives viewers a glimpse of this exceptional true wildlife story. The film follows "Mum's" latest pup, whose life is filled with challenges and adversity. From hungry stray dogs to losing his mother, the pup's journey reminds us how tenuous and fragile life is for this species.

Whetu Rere - the sea lion and the comet marks both Kat Baulu's and Alastair Jamieson's debut in wildlife filmmaking, and was produced as a collaboration and part of their Post Graduate Diploma in Natural History Filmmaking and Communication at the University of Otago.
